

I. DEFINITIONS

- **Regulations** – this document, which in particular specifies the terms of use of the Portal available at <https://1clickrepublic.com> and the rules for making donations to the Foundation.
- **Foundation** – **TV Republika Foundation, Inc., EIN: 33-2265735** a non-profit organization registered in the State of New York, operating under the federal laws of the United States and the laws of the State of New York, with its registered office at **1140 Avenue of the Americas, 9th Floor, in the City of New York, New York 10036**.
- **Donation/Contribution** – a non-refundable payment made to the Foundation, in accordance with the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC), particularly applicable to organizations exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3).
- **Portal** – the Foundation's website, available at <https://1clickrepublic.com>, enabling Users to make Donations and access other offered functionalities.
- **User** – any individual or legal entity visiting the Portal and using its features, possessing the legal capacity to undertake legal actions in accordance with the laws applicable in the State of New York.
- **Company** – any business entity operating in accordance with the laws of its country of registration, which makes a Donation to the Foundation.
- **Individual** – a private person who uses the Portal or makes a Donation to the Foundation.
- **Donor** – an Individual or Company who makes a Donation to the Foundation via the Portal or through other permissible means.
- **Operator** – a payment processing entity that facilitates Donations to the Foundation, such as Stripe, PayPal, or any other approved payment processor compliant with the laws of the United States, including the State of New York.
- **Recurring Donation** – a form of regular support for the Foundation through monthly payments in a specified amount determined by the Donor, processed via the Operator.
- **Privacy Policy** – a document separate from the Regulations, specifying detailed rules for the processing of personal data of Users and Donors within the Portal, in compliance with federal and state regulations, including the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA), the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), and New York State Data Security Laws.
- **Data Administrator** – **TV Republika Foundation, Inc.**, responsible for determining the purposes and methods of processing personal data of Users and Donors within the Portal, acting in accordance with federal and state data protection laws, including the New York Privacy Act and, where applicable, the European Union's GDPR, when processing data of EU citizens.
- **Button** – an interactive element on the Portal that enables the execution of a specified action, including making a Donation.
- **Applicable Laws** – federal laws of the United States and the laws of the State of New York governing the Foundation's activities, including the New York Not-for-Profit Corporation Law (N-PCL).

II. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Primary Function of the Portal

The Portal, accessible at <https://1clickrepublic.com>, provides Users with a simple and convenient way to make Donations to the Foundation. Additionally, the Portal offers interested Donors the option to subscribe to the Newsletter (details about the Newsletter service are provided in Section V of these Regulations).

2. Purpose of Donations

All Donations are allocated exclusively to the statutory purposes of the Foundation, which include:

- a) Promoting the independence of media in all forms, including print, radio, television, online platforms, and others. The Foundation supports legal and natural persons in establishing and managing media ventures, with a particular focus on media that promote democratic, conservative, and liberal values.
- b) Providing support to journalists and media creators, including fostering journalistic independence and protecting freedom of speech. The Foundation offers legal and material assistance to individuals pursuing these goals.
- c) Promoting independent public debate, with a particular emphasis on engaging representatives of local communities to take action in support of their regions.
- d) Protecting cultural and natural heritage, with a focus on supporting scientific research and activities aimed at preserving cultural and natural heritage in regions of Poland and territories historically associated with the Polish state.

3. Who Can Use the Portal

- a) The Portal is intended for individuals of legal age who possess full legal capacity, as well as for legal entities and organizations with at least partial legal personality.
- b) In the case of the Portal being used by legal entities, public institutions, companies, or other organizations, actions on the Portal may only be performed by persons legally authorized to represent such entities.

4. Conditions for Becoming a Donor

Any User who meets the criteria outlined in these Regulations, particularly possessing legal capacity and accepting the Regulations, may become a Donor and support the activities of the Foundation by making a Donation through the Portal.

III. Technical Requirements

1. Required Equipment and Software

To use the Portal, the following are necessary:

- a) An electronic device capable of transmitting telecommunication data (e.g., computer, smartphone, tablet) with an operating system compatible with the Portal. It is recommended to use the latest version of the operating system to ensure optimal functionality of the Portal.
- b) Access to the Internet.
- c) An active email address.
- d) A web browser installed on the device. It is recommended to use the latest version of the browser to avoid potential issues with the Portal's functionality.

2. User Responsibility for Data Accuracy

Users are responsible for providing accurate and truthful information, particularly the correctness of the email address used when making a Donation.

3. Acceptance of the Regulations and Privacy Policy

To make a Donation through the Portal, Users must accept these Regulations and the Portal's Privacy Policy.

4. Rules for Data Processing

The rules for processing personal data of Users and Donors are outlined in Section IX of these Regulations and detailed in the Privacy Policy.

5. Portal Maintenance and Updates

The Foundation reserves the right to temporarily deactivate the Portal for maintenance, modifications, or improvements. The Foundation will make every effort to perform such tasks in a manner that minimizes inconvenience to Users and Donors.

IV. Making Donations

1. Donation Process through the Portal

To make a Donation via the Portal, the User must follow these steps:

- a) Specify the amount they wish to donate to the Foundation (they can select one of the suggested amounts available on the Portal's buttons or enter a custom amount).
- b) Click the "Support" button or another payment option available on the Portal.
- c) The User is redirected to the STRIPE payment panel, where they:
 - o Select their preferred payment method,
 - o Accept the terms and conditions of the Operator (Stripe),
 - o Finalize the payment process.

2. Payment Operator

All payments made through the Portal are processed by STRIPE in accordance with its terms and conditions. By making a payment, the User agrees to the terms of service provided by STRIPE.

3. Email Confirmations

- a) Upon initiating the payment process, the User will receive an email from STRIPE confirming the start of the transaction.
- b) After completing the payment, the Foundation will send a thank-you email to the User's provided email address.

4. Technical Support

- a) If the User encounters any issues with the payment process or accessing the Portal, they can contact the Foundation via email at:

- b) The Foundation does not provide technical support related to the User's equipment or Internet connection.

V. Complaints

1. Submitting Complaints

Complaints related to the operation of the Portal should be submitted:

2. Complaint Content

To facilitate and expedite the processing of complaints, it is recommended to include the following information in the complaint:

- Email address,
 - Type and date of the issue encountered,
 - Contact details allowing for a response to the complaint.
3. **Timeframe for Processing Complaints**
Complaints related to the operation of the Portal will be processed promptly, but no later than 14 days from the date of receipt.
 4. **Response Format**
The response to the complaint will be sent to the email address provided by the User in the complaint.
 5. **Complaints Related to Donation Transactions**
All questions, concerns, or complaints regarding the processing of Donation transactions should be directed to the payment Operator using the contact form available at <https://stripe.com/contact>.

VI. Copyrights

1. **Intellectual Property**
All content published by the Foundation on the Portal, including text, graphics, logos, button icons, images, source code, software, technical solutions, and databases, constitutes the intellectual property of the Foundation and is protected under copyright law.
2. **License to Use the Portal**
The Foundation grants Users a non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable, and limited license to use the Portal. This license is valid only during the actual use of the Portal and allows Users to temporarily reproduce the Portal's content by displaying it in a web browser solely for purposes consistent with the Portal's intended use and functionality.
3. **License Restrictions**
 - a) Users are not granted any rights to the Portal's content, including intellectual property rights, beyond those explicitly stated in these Regulations.
 - b) Users are prohibited from utilizing, modifying, copying, distributing, or decompiling the Portal's source code.
4. **Copyright Infringement**
In the event of a violation of any of the above obligations, the Foundation reserves the right to take appropriate legal action against the User, including pursuing claims for infringement of proprietary copyright.

VII. Personal Data

1. **Data Controller**
The Data Controller for personal data processed within the Portal is **TV Republika Foundation, Inc.**. In connection with the processing of Donations via the Payment Operator (e.g., STRIPE), the Operator is an independent Data Controller for Donor personal data.
2. **Scope of Data Processing**
Each Data Controller processes only the personal data of Donors necessary for the proper execution of the Donation.
3. **Data Protection**
Personal data is protected by each Data Controller in compliance with applicable laws and will not be shared, sold, or disclosed to unauthorized third parties or institutions.

4. **Donor Rights**

Donors have the right to:

- a) Access their personal data,
- b) Verify and modify their data,
- c) Request the deletion of their data from the database,
- d) Request the transfer of their data to another Data Controller.

To exercise these rights, the Donor should contact the Data Controller.

5. **Complaint Regarding Data Processing**

If a Donor believes their personal data is being processed in violation of applicable laws, they have the right to file a complaint with the appropriate supervisory authority.

6. **Data Retention Period**

The personal data of Donors will be processed for the duration of the agreement and for the time necessary to address any claims related to the Donation.

7. **Payment Operator**

Information about the processing of personal data by the Payment Operator (STRIPE) can be found at: <https://stripe.com/privacy>.

8. **Data Processed for Newsletter Subscription**

If a Donor subscribes to the Newsletter, personal data in the form of an email address will be processed by the entity responsible for providing the Newsletter service.

9. **Privacy Policy**

Detailed information regarding the rules for processing personal data within the Portal is included in the **Privacy Policy**, available on the Portal.

VIII. Final Provisions

1. **Availability of the Regulations**

The current version of the Regulations is available on the website: <https://1clickrepublic.com>. Each time a User makes a Donation, they must accept the applicable version of the Regulations and the Privacy Policy.

2. **Recurring Donations**

For recurring Donations, the Donor is bound by the terms of the Regulations and the Privacy Policy in effect at the time of the first Payment under the recurring Donation.

3. **Legal Nature of the Regulations**

Acceptance of the Regulations and the Privacy Policy by the Donor constitutes the conclusion of a Donation agreement between the Foundation and the Donor.

4. **Applicable Laws**

In matters not regulated by these Regulations, the provisions of applicable laws of the United States and the State of New York shall apply, particularly those governing non-profit organizations and Donations.

5. **Donor Obligations**

The Donor is obligated to comply with all provisions of these Regulations.
